The “**27th Annual National Night Out**” (NNO), a unique crime prevention event sponsored by the National Association of Town Watch (NATW), has been scheduled for **Tuesday, August 3, 2010**. We cordially invite you and your community to be part of our NIGHT OUT 2010 team.

Last year’s National Night Out campaign involved citizens, law enforcement agencies, civic groups, businesses, neighborhood organizations and local officials from 14,625 communities from all 50 states, U.S. territories, Canadian cities and military bases worldwide. In all, 36.7 million people participated in NNO 2009. This year’s “27th Annual NNO” will be the largest ever!
