Customers will be provided with a message on their Digital Control Terminal informing them of the scheduled update.

**WHEREAS**, every household should have working smoke detectors and a family escape plan; and

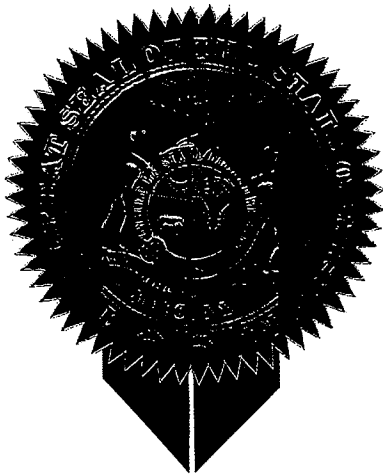
**WHEREAS**, with the help of public education programs, Missourians are able to take personal steps to increase their safety from fire.



In the 2008/2009-year NCTV made the leap to the Internet, served as a site for ROP Video Production, cultivated and trained new community oriented producers and programs, continued to upgrade and replace production equipment and facilities, and increased its visibility by adding a logo to both the NCTV (11) and NCTV-G (17) broadcast signals.

This year has underscored the vital position Nevada County Television holds as a communications resource for the community. NCTV provides the public an electronic venue for free speech, and a transparent view into our local government proceedings.

Below is a reporting of NCTV capital funding sources and uses as required by the multi-jurisdictional MOU.
