HD Tech and Additional Outlet Fees LFA Notification

Dear Mr. Albaugh:

In our on-going effort to keep you informed, I am writing to notify you that Comcast is eliminating its equipment rental fees for high definition video services for virtually all of our customers.

Effective on or after February 1, 2010, Comcast will no longer charge monthly HD equipment rental fees. Customers who receive high definition video services will now, however, be charged a \$8.00 HD Technology Fee.^[1] There will be no change in Comcast's existing HD DVR Service Fees, which will now include the HD Technology Fee.

This HD Technology Fee will help Comcast to recover the additional costs incurred in upgrading its network to provide high definition (HD) television services. Comcast has invested millions of dollars in its network to provide these advanced video services to its customers.

The HD Technology Fee applies to each television outlet served by Comcast receiving high definition video services.

In addition, on or after February 1, 2010 Comcast will combine the advanced equipment and Digital Programming Access fees on additional outlets to one *lower* package price: \$8.00 for a HD converter, \$8.95 for DVR services and \$15.95 for HD DVR service.

RE: Intention to Conduct Waste Tire Enforcement Program

Dear Mr. Albaugh:


Pursuant to California Public Resources Code §42889(b)(4), the Nevada County Department of Environmental Health (NCDEH) is applying for a Waste Tire Enforcement Grant (Grant) from the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) for the period June 30, 2010 through June 30, 2011. If a Grant is received, NCDEH will have the authority to enforce regulations relating to the storage of waste and used tires as provided in California Public Resources Code §42850(c), and regulations relating to the hauling of waste and used tires as provided in California Public Resources Code §42963(b), for the period June 30, 2010 through June 30, 2011. In that capacity, employees of NCDEH plan to conduct waste tire enforcement activities within your jurisdiction, including, but not limited to:

- inspections of waste tire businesses;
- surveillance to deter and identify illegal dumping of waste tires;
- Identify funding sources and conduct cleanup of illegally dumped waste tires
- outreach to waste tire businesses to inform them of applicable waste tire laws, regulations and available options for proper management of waste tires; and,
- possible citation of businesses and others that are consistently out of compliance with applicable waste tire laws and regulations.
