and stay on the designed trail switchbacks.

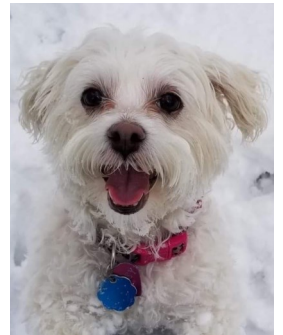
### Trail Volunteering
