

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-91

APPROVAL OF THE “NEVADA CITY SAFE” BUSINESS SELF- CERTIFICATION SAFETY PROGRAM WITHIN THE CITY OF NEVADA CITY FOR THE DURATION OF THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

WHEREAS, At the November 20, 2020, Special City Council meeting, the City Council directed staff to create an easily recognizable brand “Nevada City Safe” self-certification program/educational campaign to help identify to the public which businesses in the City are following safety protocols and enforcing the State Face Covering Guidance; and

WHEREAS, Council and staff felt that this program is a positive way to encourage safety compliance and to encourage customers and the public to support the local businesses that are participating in this program; and

WHEREAS, Staff and Council have put together a simple program including educational posters placed strategically at each entrance into the City, a Poster that businesses can place at the entrance of their place of business identifying them as a self-certified “Nevada City Safe” business, a short self-certification form that would be signed by the participating business as well as a City Official and a long form for businesses who do not currently have a written site specific plan; and

WHEREAS, This program will be branded “Nevada City Safe” and is meant to encourage businesses to identify themselves as following and enforcing the safety guidelines that the State requires of every business.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Nevada City approve of the Resolution 2020-XX the “Nevada City Safe” Business Self-Certification Safety Program within the City of Nevada City for the Duration of the COVID-19 Pandemic.
