Synopsis: Your Engine Company will be responding as an Initial Attack Single Resource of 12-20 engines, to a rapidly growing wildfire, within a community of 1500 homes. Their task will be to obtain a briefing, communicate their arrival for an assignment, navigate to the appropriate Divisions for work in multiple, non-stop, proctor evaluated scenarios of:

- Structure Size-up
- Structure Defense Tactics (Home Prep and Hose deployment)
- Crew life safety measures and Escape Plan
- Assisting L.E with emergency Large Scale evacuation operations (Residents and Pets)
- WUI Placarding of the residence and home-owner preparedness interaction
- Reporting and mitigating an IWI (working with EMS and Law Enforcement)
- Assisting with a multi-company progressive hose lay
- Hand Line Construction
- Firefighter survival strategy and tactics during a crew entrapment/burn-over simulation.
